

Schaefer Lake Lot Owners Association

Powered Watercraft Registration Policy

1. All lots in good standing will be allowed to register powered watercraft.
2. Only registered powered watercraft will have lake access.
- 3. No guest watercraft will be allowed on the lake due to liability issues.**
4. All powered watercraft will require registration.
- 5. All powered watercraft must display the registration sticker on the right rear corner.**

Annual Registration Process

1. Complete the Schaefer Lake Lot Owners Association Powered Watercraft Registration Form
2. Sticker will be provided if the lot is in good standing.

Test Driving Policy

Test drives will be limited to one hour and the member shall notify the Secretary of the Board of Directors.

Violation of Watercraft Registration Policy

Violators to the Powered Watercraft Registration Policy will be provided a Notice of Registration Violation for the SLLOA in written form. Fines to the Powered Watercraft Registration Policy will be assessed by the following:

- A. A non-registered boat which satisfies the Proof of Ownership requirements on Schaefer Lake will be given a two week grace period in which to complete the registration process. If the boat is not properly registered or not removed within two weeks, a \$50.00 per day fine will be assessed, retroactive back to the date the Notice of Violation was given to the lot owner.
- B. The lot owner who allows a guest watercraft onto Schaefer Lake will be fined \$250.00 per occurrence and the boat must be removed immediately, unless the boat complies with the Test Driving Policy.
