2 nominated to fill board openings; 1 more SLLOA candidate needed

Three board positions will be open when the new fiscal year for the Schaefer Lake Lot Owners Association begins following the March 30 annual meeting.

- Board president Rob Dailey is completing his second three-year term on the board. Term limits prevent Dailey from seeking a third straight term on the Schaefer Lake Lot Owners Association board.
- Board treasurer Rob Daly is completing a three-year term, but won't be seeking re-election at this year's annual meeting.
- Brad Anderson's three-year term also expires, but Anderson has agreed to serve one additional year to complete the final year of Brett Engel's term. Engel, who previously served a six-year term on the board, has served five years in his second stint on the board, most recently as vice president, and has expressed a desire to step down.

The SLLOA nomination committee has placed the names of lot owners Ben Coy and Schuyler Marks on the proxy ballot, sent to property owners in a recent mailing.

- Ben Coy and his wife Sarah moved to Schaefer Lake in September 2020. They live at 16022 E. Lakeshore Drive S.
- Schuyler Marks and his wife Tracy moved to Schaefer Lake in December 2020. They live at 16052 E. Lakeshore Drive S.

However, with three openings, the board is seeking at least one more Schaefer Lake property owner to run serve for a three-year term. Update on emergency spillway progress (Scott Towsley)

- It was brought up about the potential for someone to mistakenly drive onto the backside of the emergency spillway area. Should the board install signs to keep people off the emergency spillway? Scott to investigate the cost of signs for the emergency spillway.
- Burke Engineering is working on the as-built drawings post-construction of the emergency spillway. Upon reviewing the survey data, it appeared that the trigger notch in the new emergency spillway is not meeting the design print requirements. Burke Engineering has contacted Percival Excavating about returning to the site to make the necessary minor modifications. Scott Towsley will be working with Percival and Burke on the corrections.

Update on Dredging (Brent Engel)

■ Jen Hellmich inquired about more neighboring property to lease for deposit of dredged material. Part of the acreage is under contract and not available. Owner has contacted Heartland to schedule a site visit to check feasibility of use. Board members to also attend site visit when planned.

Update on emergency spillway progress (Scott Towsley)

Burke, in reviewing the survey data of the emergency spillway, noticed that the critical feature of the pilot channel was roughly 3 inches lower than it should be. Burke has arranged with Percival Excavation to return to Schaefer Lake on Jan. 14 to add gravel up to the necessary pilot channel height. After this is verified with the surveyors who will also be on site, Burke can continue working on completion of the as-built drawings, then present the documentation to the Indiana DNR in first quarter of this year.

Update on Dredging (Brent Engel)

SLLOA has set up a visit to a second neighboring property with Heartland Dredging to review the site as a potential silt deposit site. No additional conversation with other neighboring property owners has taken place since the last time.

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Annual meeting

- Rob Dailey will create a draft version of the annual meeting presentation, including annual budget. Board will need to keep a little money in for the emergency spillways for Patriot and other expenses.
- Board member whose terms are ending: Rob Dailey, Rob Daly and Brad Anderson. Will reach out for potential new board members.

Treasurer's report and financial update (Rob Daly)

- Two lots remain for outstanding dues in 2021. SLLOA has received one payment for 2022.
- Reviewed the 2021 actuals and 2022 proposed budget. All approved the proposed 2022 budget.

Update on emergency spillway progress (Scott Towsley)

Burke Engineering, Land Surveyors and Percival Excavation returned Jan. 15 to fine-tune the pilot channel heights to meet the design intent. All correction work was completed on the emergency spillway. Project completion documentation was filed Feb. 15 with the Indiana DNR. Emergency Spillway project is complete. Final invoices should roll in from Burke during March.

Update on Dredging (Brent Engel)

Met with neighboring property owner #2 in January to walk the property with Heartland Dredging to assess for possible silt deposit site. There is a lot of acreage, but it has a significant number of valleys that will increase the cost of building containment berms. Overall, the property can hold approximately 75,000 cubic yards, although it would require added cost for a high berm. The property owner is currently thinking over the cost of leasing the property to SLLOA.

Heartland Dredging is estimating the capacity of yardage that can be put on another neighboring property. Next step: Meet with neighboring property owner #3 about using their property. Possible options are:

Property #1 (75,000 cubic yards) + Property #2 (45,000 cubic yards) Property #1 (75,000 cubic yards) + Property #3 (45,000 cubic yards)

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Annual meeting

- Continue to work on 2022 budget and annual meeting prep. Board will need to keep reserve for Emergency Spillway for Patriot, etc.
- Board member whose terms are ending: Rob Dailey, Rob Daly and Brad Anderson. Will continue to reach out for potential new board members.
